CONVENTION ON THE INTERNATIONAL REGULATIONS FOR PREVENTING COLLISIONS AT SEA, 1972

Accession by Iraq

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Convention on the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, 1972, and to state that, in accordance with article II(3), accession by the Republic of Iraq was effected by the deposit of an instrument on 4 January 2018.

The Convention entered into force for Iraq on 4 January 2018, in accordance with article IV(3).

There are, at present, 158 Contracting States to the Convention, representing approximately 99.17%* of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant shipping.
